FEU TUITION DISCOUNT (FTD)
For students with less than P360,000.00 combined annual family income with at least C (2.50) QPA and no failed or dropped courses in the preceding semester. Grantee must enroll a minimum load of 15 units and provide proof of income.

# GRADUATE STUDIES TUITION DISCOUNT

Open for FEU alumni, full-time professionals, government employees, school guidance counselors, nurses, and teachers. Tuition discounts range from 25 percent (alumni) and 50 percent to 75 percent (professionals).

SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP GRANTS
For qualified athletes, members of the cheerleading squad and members of the President's Committee on Culture (PCC) groups. Benefits for athletes and cheerleading squad members include full tuition and assessed miscellaneous fees discount, while qualified members of the PCC are granted either full or partial tuition discount

Apart from university-funded scholarships, our industry partners also offer grants for qualified students. However, FEU implements a one-student, one-scholarship policy. If a student qualifies for both university-funded and externally funded grants, the student must choose which grant to avail through a waiver documenting their decision. Additionally, grants are revoked upon cancellation of enrolment since the grant's purpose has not been met.

# REGISTRATION

All those who completed senior high school or acquired its equivalent (Philippine Educational Placement Test or Non-Formal Equivalency Test given and certified by the Department of Education) are eligible to apply for the FEU College Admission Test. the University's screening and selection assessment.

## Online registration steps \*\*:

- 1. Go to the link https://admission.feu.edu.ph and click the "Register" checkbox.
- 2. Fill in the necessary information.
- 3. Open the registered email account and read the instructions from FEU Admissions.
- 4. Log in at https://admission.feu.edu.ph using your registered account.
- 5. Fill out-admission form.
- 6. Choose your preferred examination schedule.
- 7. Print the confirmation letter.

\* Note: For bank transactions, kindly bring your payment slip during exam day.

- \*\* For non-FEU graduate MBA applicants:
- · Prior online application, kindly secure your endorsement form at the Admissions and Financial Assistance (AFA) Office.
- · Proceed to the concerned institute for your initial evaluation. Bring a photocopy of your Transcript of Records with at least 2.0 GWA and a photocopy of your diploma. Also provide a photocopy of professional license if applicable.
- · Return the endorsement form to the AFA office and proceed with the online registration steps.
- · After passing the Graduate Level Test (GLT), submit requirements to the institute or admissions office and retrieve your initial evaluation documents from the AFA.
- · Proceed to your institute for final evaluation and return to AFA for enrollment date and procedure.
