Policy on FEU Learning Modalities

Beginning First Semester, SY 2025–2026

Starting this First Semester of SY 2025–2026, FEU is rolling out a blended learning setup—and this policy is your guide to making the most of it! You'll be attending classes both on campus and online, with Mondays to Wednesdays for face-to-face learning, and Thursdays to Saturdays for online sessions.

Policy on FEU Learning Modalities beginning First Semester, SY 2025-2026

Rationale

This policy supports FEU's commitment to enhancing students' digital literacy through blended learning for most courses. By combining onsite instruction with online and independent learning, students are given the opportunity to develop essential digital competencies that are increasingly vital to both academic and professional settings—such as navigating learning platforms, engaging in virtual collaboration, and managing digital workflows.

The flexibility of this model also acknowledges that FEU students are adult learners who benefit from a structure that allows them to balance academic responsibilities with personal and professional commitments. The offsite learning does enable students to manage their time, deepen their learning independently, and engage with digital tools in meaningful ways.

Similarly, this policy supports faculty development by promoting the use of digital tools and innovative teaching strategies. The blended format empowers faculty to create more engaging, flexible learning experiences while maintaining access to campus resources and collaborative spaces.

Beginning First Semester of SY 2025-2026, FEU will adopt a blended learning modality for the majority of its classes.

Format

With the exception of selected laboratory courses, selected professional courses, and WRI, and all Nursing courses, all FEU courses will adopt a blended learning format. Courses that will adopt a blended learning format will hold, onsite, synchronous, and face-to-face classes every Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday. They will then hold online classes every Thursday, Friday, and Saturday. To ensure that the targeted learning competencies are met, the Institute or Department, in collaboration with the faculty members teaching the course and in consultation with the students, will determine the manner of off-site engagements, either by independent study or by online synchronous meetings. The schedule of class meetings will be set and communicated during the first week of classes.

Device and Connectivity Requirements

To fully participate in blended learning, all FEU students are expected to have access to their own devices (laptops, desktops, tablets, or smart phones) that are internet capable and will allow them to join an online class or access Canvas. Students who do not have access to these devices may use the devices at the library (e-library section) or in designated rooms for online engagement. There will be designated rooms with WFI access but students must bring their own devices.

Use of Canvas and Teams

To ensure seamless communication between all teaching and learning stakeholders, students and faculty members are required to communicate on matters pertaining to their courses through Canvas or through Teams. All learning material should be uploaded on Canvas and written assessments should, whenever possible, be posted and submitted through Canvas.

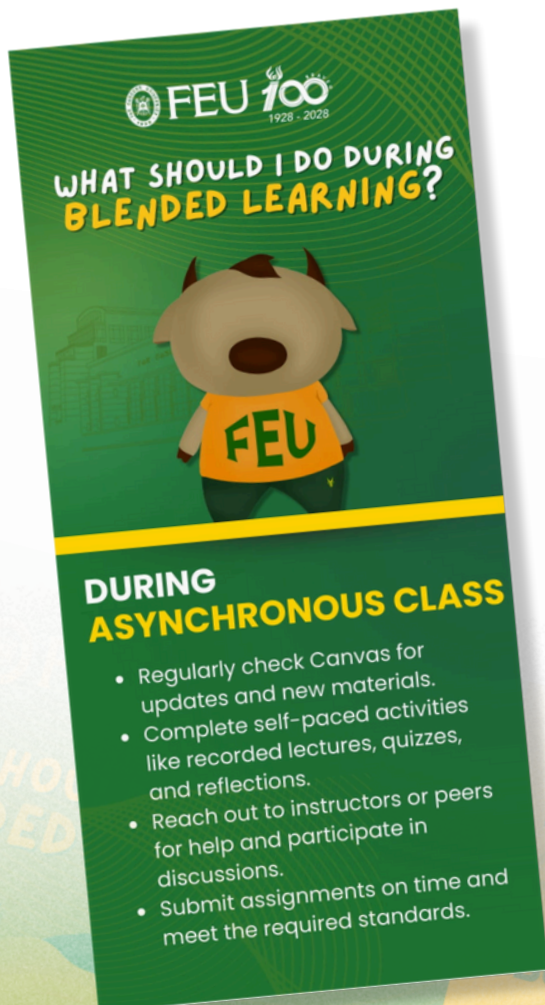

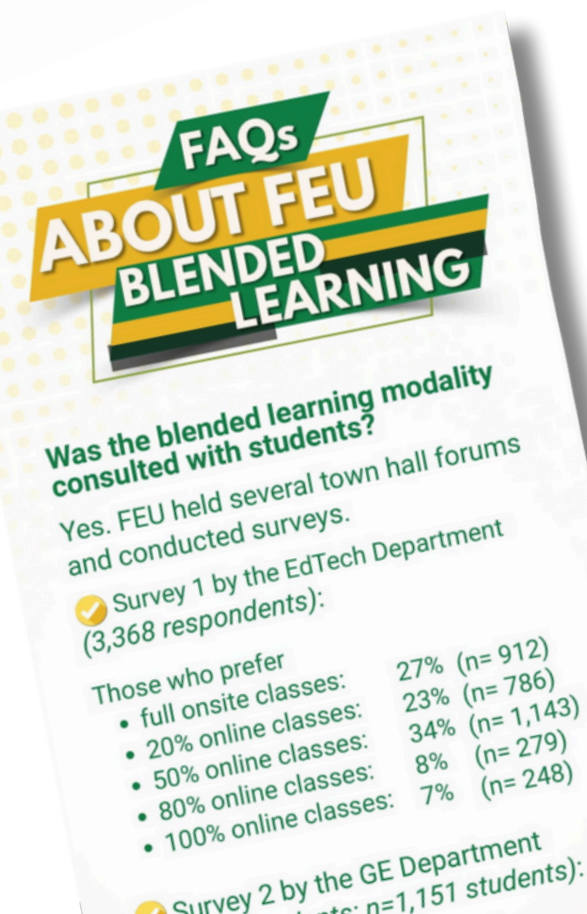

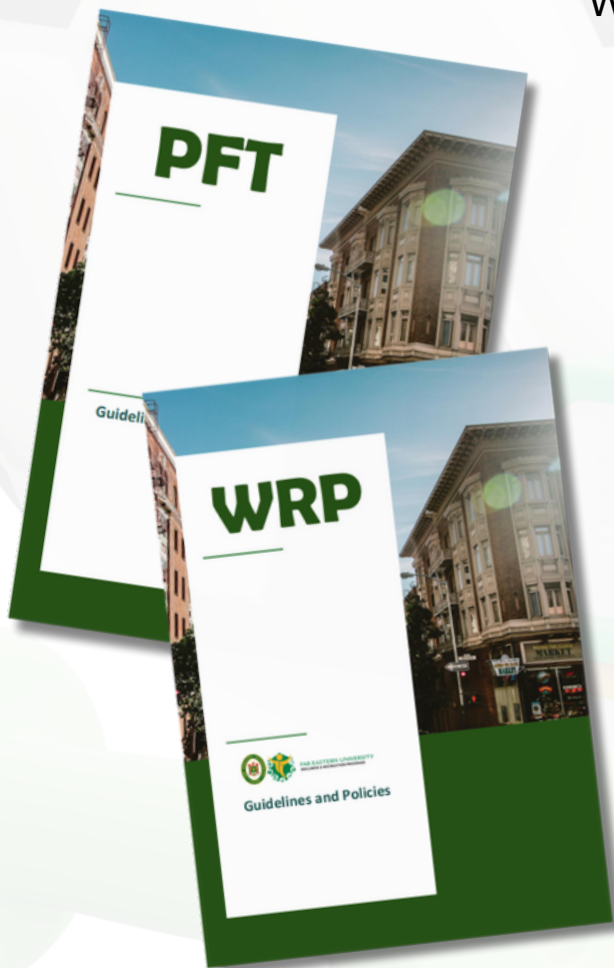


WRP and PATHFIT Guidelines
